WHEREAS, the City Council in Closed Session on September 25, 2012 authorized settlement of the Litigation for an amount consistent with the amounts set forth below and pursuant to such other terms more fully set forth in the Settlement Agreement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the council authorizes:

- 1. Authorizing the sum of \$75,000 to be paid from the Public Liability Fund No. 720045, in settlement of each and every claim for damages, interest, costs, and fees of any type, including attorney fees, against City of San Diego, its agents and employees, arising from the personal injury claim of Joseph Opp, San Diego Superior Court Case No. 37-2011-00096401-CU-PO-CTL.
- 2. Authorizing the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend \$75,000 from the Public Liability Fund, Fund 720045, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

3. Authorizing the Comptroller to issue a check in the amount of \$75,000, made payable to the Law Offices of Steven Williams for the benefit of Joseph Opp.
