A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN
DIEGO APPROVING THE SETTLEMENT BETWEEN
MELISSA WILDE AND THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO

WHEREAS, on April 26, 2012, Plaintiff Melissa Wilde filed suit against the City of San Diego [City] alleging personal injuries arising from an incident which occurred on November 15, 2010. The suit is entitled *Melissa Wilde v. City of San Diego, et al.*, Case No 12cv1262 DMS (BGS) [Litigation]; and

WHEREAS, the City Council in Closed Session on July 10, 2012 and September 18, 2012, authorized settlement of the Litigation for an amount consistent with the amounts set forth below and pursuant to such other terms more fully set forth in the Settlement Agreement; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the council authorizes:

1. Authorizing the sum of \$675,000 to be paid from the Public Liability Fund No. 720045, in settlement of each and every claim for damages, interest, costs and fees of any type, including attorney fees, against the City, its agents and employees, arising from the personal injury claim of Melissa Wilde, United States District Court Case No. 12cv1262 DMS (BGS).

2. Authorizing the Chief Financial Officer to appropriate and expend \$675,000 from the Public Liability Fund 720045, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.


3. Authorizing the Comptroller to issue a check in the amount of \$675,000 made payable to the Mitchell & Gileon client trust account and their client, Melissa Wilde.
