WHEREAS, the Commission for Arts and Culture (Commission) is established in the San Diego Municipal Code (Municipal Code) under Chapter 2, Article 6, Division 7, to advise the Mayor and City Council on promoting, encouraging, and increasing support for the region's artistic and cultural assets, integrating arts and culture into community life, and showcasing San Diego as an international tourist destination; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the Commission shall consist of fifteen members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that of the fifteen members: (1) the Mayor shall appoint seven members directly, and (2) the Mayor shall appoint the remaining eight members, one each from a list of three nominations submitted by each Councilmember; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that members shall serve two-year staggered terms; each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed; and all terms must have expiration dates of August 31; and

WHEREAS, members shall be persons who represent the following: individual arts and culture patrons, artists, educators, the business and professional community, those with professional qualifications and experience or knowledge of a particular arts and culture field, and the general public; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointment and reappointments by the Mayor of the City of San Diego, to serve as members of

the Commission for Arts and Culture, for terms expiring as indicated, are made and hereby confirmed:
