RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 307863  
DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE NOV 27 2012

WHEREAS, the Human Relations Commission (Commission) is established in the San Diego Municipal Code, in sections 26.0901 through 26.0911, to advise the Mayor and City Council on the rights of every inhabitant of the City of San Diego to equal economic, political and educational opportunity; to equal accommodations in all business establishments in the City; and to equal service and protection by public agencies; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that the Commission shall consist of fifteen members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council; and


WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that members shall serve staggered four-year terms, except that vacancies occurring during a term shall be filled for the remainder of the unexpired term; and

WHEREAS, the Municipal Code provides that, of the fifteen members, (1) the Mayor shall appoint seven members directly; and (2) the Mayor shall appoint eight additional members, one each from a list of up to three nominations submitted by each Councilmember; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego that the following appointment by the Mayor of the City of San Diego, to serve as a member of the Human Relations Commission, for the term ending as indicated, is made and hereby confirmed:


