A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO ADD A CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT, TRANSFER FUNDS, AUTHORIZE AND EXPEND AN ALLOCATION OF \$25,000 TO PARTIALLY FUND THE DESIGN OF THE MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. PROMENADE PROJECT.

WHEREAS, this action is to request authorization to allocate \$25,000 in City Council District 4 Community Projects, Programs, and Services Funds (CPPS) to partially fund the total expected design cost of \$284,000 for the Martin Luther King Jr. Promenade Project (Project); and

WHEREAS, the area limits of the Project are Martin Luther King Jr. Way from Tiffin Avenue to Charlene Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the scope of the Project is to construct a cultural promenade area including pedestrian areas, fitness areas, seating, landscaping, community identification signs, artwork, utility relocation, new street section, retaining walls, and free-standing walls; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) is authorized to add Capital Improvements Project (CIP) S-13020 Martin Luther King Jr. Promenade, to the Capital Improvements Program; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the CFO is authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$25,000 from the General Fund, Fund 100000, Council District Four (4) to Fund 400265, General Fund Contributions to the CIP; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the CFO is authorized to increase the Capital Improvements Program Budget in CIP S-13020, Martin Luther King Jr. Promenade, and to appropriate and expend an amount of \$25,000 from Fund 400265, General Fund Contributions to the CIP, for the purpose of funding design of the Project.
