A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING THE 2012 YEAR-END REPORT AND FIRST YEAR RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT AND STRATEGIES COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, in January 2012, the City Council established the Council Committee on Economic Development and Strategies responsible for reviewing, holding hearings, and making recommendations to the City Council concerning the City's economic development programs and strategies; and


WHEREAS, on October 22, 2012, the Committee reviewed the Committee's Year End Report and First Year Recommendations and voted unanimously to recommend the Report and Recommendations to the City Council for the purpose of providing the City Council with a progress report on the work of the Committee in its inaugural year and the Committee's recommendations; and

WHEREAS, in addition to non-substantive clean-up edits, the following revisions were made after the Committee's consideration and are included in the Report: a "next step/future action" was added regarding expansion of educational mentorship programs and regarding the military with respect to Pacific Rim realignment, cyber security and transitioning veterans to civilian work; and updated information reflecting actions taken since October 2012;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the 2012 Year-End Report and First Year Recommendations of the Economic Development and Strategies Committee to the City Council, is hereby accepted as an informational report to the City Council.


