WHEREAS, entering into a Relinquishment Agreement with Caltrans, for the relinquishment of a portion of Interstate 5 right-of-way on Roselle Street to City will facilitate and expedite the completion of the traffic signal (Relinquishment Agreement); and

WHEREAS, it is agreed that Caltrans' obligation to provide ninety (90) days notice of its intention to relinquish as set forth in Streets and Highways Code section 73 is waived; NOW, THEREFORE,
