A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND  
EXPENDITURE OF CALTRANS GRANT FUNDING FOR  
THE BRIDGE PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, this action is to accept federal funds for the Bridge Preventative Maintenance Program through the State Department of Transportation (Caltrans); and

WHEREAS, the objective of the bridge program is to identify effective preventative maintenance measures and a preventative maintenance routine to extend the life of all vehicular bridges that are locally maintained; and


WHEREAS, the cost for fourteen vehicular bridges has been determined from the City of San Diego Bridge Preventative Maintenance Plan Report; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept two Program Supplement Agreements from Caltrans and to take all necessary actions to secure funding in the amount of \$34,844 in State Funds, federally awarded for the Bridge Preventive Maintenance on various off-system and on-system bridges.
2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$7,542 from Fund 600001, State, federal award, Grant #1000387-2013, Bridge PM#1 and \$27,302 from Fund 600001, State, federal award, Grant #1000388-2013, Bridge PM#2, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant, if required.
