

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 20267 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JUN 12 2013

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MONTH-TO-MONTH EXTENSION OF UP TO NINETY DAYS OF THE CURRENT CONTRACT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND U.S. HEALTH WORKS MEDICAL GROUP.

WHEREAS, a comprehensive medical examination program has been adopted by the San Diego Civil Service Commission in order to protect the safety of our employees and the public; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego has medical examination and drug testing programs which are intended to help limit the number and cost of injuries and the City's liability, yet still permit consideration and employment of all applicants and employees who can safely perform the duties of the jobs for which they are being considered or employed; and

WHEREAS, the drug testing is provided for in the Memoranda of Understanding of the three affected bargaining units; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Department does not have the facilities or qualified staff to perform medical examinations or drug testing; and

WHEREAS, in 2008, the City awarded a contract for Medical Examination and Drug Testing services to U.S. Health Works Medical Group for a period of two years with the option of three, one-year extensions (San Diego Resolution R-303883 (Jun. 24, 2008)); and

WHEREAS, the option for these one-year extensions was exercised with the final, one-year extension set to expire on June 30, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the City has issued a request for proposals for the provision of these services; and

WHEREAS, the Request for Proposals (RFP) No. 10033790-13-V for Employment and DMV Medical Exams and Drug Testing closed on March 29, 2013, and the bids for contracts are currently being evaluated by Personnel and the Purchasing and Contracting Department; and

WHEREAS, the Personnel Department is seeking approval of a month-to-month extension up to ninety days of the current agreement with U.S. Health Works Medical Group so these services are not interrupted while the evaluation process continues; and

WHEREAS, as the contract extension sought would render the present contract valid beyond five years, a two-thirds majority of the San Diego City Council is required for approval pursuant to San Diego Charter section 99; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor is authorized and directed to execute a month-to-month extension up to ninety days of the existing contract with U.S. Health Works Medical Group to provide employment and DMV medical examinations, drug testing and related medical services.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend the amount of \$119,662 from the General/Enterprise Funds in Fiscal Year 2014 for the months commencing July 1, 2013 through September 30, 2013 contingent upon passage of the annual appropriations ordinance.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from
and after its final passage.




