AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH SIMON WONG ENGINEERING, INC. FOR THE TED WILLIAMS PARKWAY PEDESTRIAN OVERCROSSING AT SHOAL CREEK IN THE CARMEL MOUNTAIN RANCH COMMUNITY PLAN AREA.

WHEREAS, Simon Wong Engineering, Inc. entered into a consultant agreement with the City of San Diego to provide professional engineering services for the Ted William Parkway Pedestrian Overcrossing at Shoal Creek (Project) on September 18, 2007, as Document No. RR-303002; and

WHEREAS, the City and Simon Wong Engineering entered into a First Amendment to the consultant agreement on October 4, 2010, as Document No. RR-306144; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Second Amendment to the agreement with Simon Wong Engineering, Inc. is required for the purpose of an extension of time to allow for the completion of construction for the Project (CIP S-00941, Ted Williams Parkway Pedestrian Overcrossing at Shoal Creek); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor be and he is hereby authorized and directed, to execute, for and on behalf of said City, a second amendment to the consultant agreement with Simon Wong Engineering, Inc. for the purpose of completing the Ted Williams Parkway Overcrossing at Shoal Creek under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 2027, together with any reasonably necessary modifications or amendments thereto which do not increase project scope or cost and which the

Mayor shall deem necessary from time to time in order to carry out the purposes and intent of this project and agreement.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
