AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AWARD OF JOB ORDER CONTRACT AND INCREASING TASK ORDER AMOUNT IN VARIANCE TO SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 22.3104(a) FOR JOB ORDER CONTRACT NUMBER ONE FOR STREET PAVING

WHEREAS, the City's Public Works Department would like to issue two Job Order Contracts (JOC) and task orders thereunder to provide as-needed construction services City-wide for specific work trades related to street repairs to allow work to be executed quickly and efficiently without having to individually procure services for each specific project; and

WHEREAS, the City would like to issue JOC Number One for street paving to be individually administered, and once funds for the JOC are depleted, a second JOC (companion ordinance) will be opened; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code (SDMC) section 22.3103 provides authorization for a JOC in an amount not to exceed \$10,000,000 for an individual JOC without City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, SDMC section 22.3104 provides authorization for individual task orders under a JOC in an amount not to exceed \$1,000,000 without City Council approval; and

WHEREAS, in order to meet the need for significant projects and efficiently execute small emergency CIP and general construction projects, the City Council will not apply the provisions of SDMC section 22.3104 for purposes of Job Order Contract for Street Paving (Project) only, and approve an increase in the individual task authorization for this JOC to an amount not to exceed \$5,000,000; and

WHEREAS, the Project Task Orders are subject to reimbursement from State grants, and subject to State prevailing wage requirements; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the plans and technical specifications for this Project including prevailing wage specifications as advertised by the Public Works Purchasing and Contracting Department, filed in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. **DO-20297**, are approved.

Section 2. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to increase the task order amount from \$1,000,000 to an amount not to exceed the sum of \$5,000,000.

Section 3. That, after advertising for bids in accordance with law, the Mayor or his designee is authorized to award the Project contract to the lowest responsible and reliable bidder with the lowest total unit cost in an amount not to exceed \$15,000,000, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasury.

Section 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$15,000,000, over two years to provide funds for the Project, contingent on adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year.

Section 5. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$10,000 from Fund No. 400624, "Deferred Maintenance Transportation Annual Allocation," solely and exclusively to provide funds meeting minimum contract requirements for the Project.

Section 6. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to include state prevailing wage requirements in the contracts awarded for this Project.

Section 7. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council, and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 8. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
