DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE OCT 08 2013

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE CONSULTANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND SIMON WONG ENGINEERING FOR THE GEORGIA STREET BRIDGE IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Simon Wong Engineering, Inc. entered into a consultant agreement with the City of San Diego to provide professional engineering services for the Replacement of the Georgia Street Bridge Over University Avenue Phase 1 (Project) on November 18, 2008, as Document No. RR-304379; and

WHEREAS, the City and Simon Wong Engineering entered into a First Amendment to the consultant agreement on November 9, 2011, as Document No. RR-307084; and

WHEREAS, the proposed Second Amendment to the agreement with Simon Wong Engineering, Inc. is required for the purpose of an extension of time to allow for the completion of the plans, specifications, and estimate and will provide for construction support; NOW, THEREFORE;

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Council President in his capacity under Charter section 265(i), or his designee, is authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the City, to make application to Caltrans and to take all necessary actions to secure funding for Federal Grant #1000128-2003 in an amount not to exceed \$200,000 in Fund 600000.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Fiscal Year 2014 Capital Improvements Program Budget in CIP S-00863, Georgia Street Bridge Improvements,

and to accept, appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$200,000, within Fund 600000, Federal Grant #1000128-2003 HBRR-Georgia Street Bridge, contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement; contingent upon the adoption of the Fiscal Year 2014 Appropriation Ordinance.

Section 3. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$200,000 within Fund 600000, Federal Grant #1000128-2003 HBRR-Georgia St. Bridge, is hereby authorized for the purpose of providing funds for the Project, provided that the Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

Section 4. That the Council President in his capacity under Charter section 265(i), or his designee, is authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the City, to execute the Second Amendment to the Agreement with Simon Wong Engineering for the engineering services for the CIP S-00863, Georgia Street Bridge Improvements in an not to exceed \$798,200.


Section 5. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$798,200 from CIP S-00863 Georgia Street Bridge Improvements, of which \$50,000 is from Fund 600000 Federal Grant #1000128-2003 and \$748,200 is from Fund 400169, Transnet, for the purpose of funding this amendment to the original agreement with Simon Wong Engineering.

Section 6. That the City Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 7. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its final passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its final passage.

Section 8. That this ordinance shall take effect, and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
