AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH TETRA TECH, INC. FOR AS-NEEDED STORM WATER ENGINEERING CONSULTING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, on December 15, 2008, the Council of the City of San Diego authorized an agreement for storm water engineering consulting services on an as-needed basis for a term of five years, and for expenditures not to exceed \$12.5 million, with Tetra Tech, Inc. (Agreement), by San Diego Resolution R-304456 (Dec. 15, 2008); and

WHEREAS, the term of the Agreement is from January 22, 2009, to January 21, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the Storm Water Division of the Transportation & Storm Water Department is requesting to extend the term of the Agreement beyond five years with no increase in the original authorized contract amount of \$12.5 million, extending the end of the term from January 21, 2014, to June 30, 2015, to allow for the continuation of work under current task orders supporting extensive planning efforts to develop long term water quality programs required by the Municipal Separate Storm Sewer (MS4) Permit and other regulatory requirements, and Capital Improvement Projects currently in design; and

WHEREAS, because this contract extension will result in the Agreement extending beyond five years, San Diego Charter section 99 requires that Council approve this amendment by a two-thirds majority vote; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Council President in his capacity under Charter section 265(i), or his designee, is authorized and directed, for and on behalf of the City, to execute the First Amendment to the Agreement with Tetra Tech Inc., for As-Needed Storm Water Engineering Consulting Services for an additional period of approximately one and a half years, extending the term to June 30, 2015, under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Amendment to the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO-

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
