A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER, APPROPRIATION, AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR PALM TREE TRIMMING CITYWIDE.

WHEREAS, in June 2012, the Council authorized funding for tree services from the General Fund Appropriated Reserve; and

WHEREAS, in October 2012, the Budget & Finance Committee approved City staff's recommendation that the authorized funding be used to trim palm trees; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to transfer \$257,000 of appropriations from the General Fund Appropriated Reserve, Department 9915, to the Transportation & Storm Water Department, Department 2116, within the General Fund, Fund No. 100000.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to increase the Fiscal Year 2013 operating expenditure and revenue budget in the Transportation & Storm Water Department, Department 2116, within the General Fund, Fund No. 100000, by the amount of \$257,000.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$257,000 from the Transportation & Storm Water Department, Department 2116, within the General Fund, Fund No. 100000, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the above palm tree trimming services within the public right-of-way citywide, provided that the Chief Financial Officer furnishes a certificate demonstrating that the funds for this expenditure are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.


