WHEREAS, on October 6, 1993 an amendment to the Scripps Miramar Ranch
Community Plan was adopted and during the process Carroll Canyon Road I-15 and Business
Park Avenue was incorrectly identified as a 4-Lane Major Street in the Proposed Circulation
Element Map; and

WHEREAS, a technical amendment is requested to correct the previous mapping error by changing the classification of Carroll Canyon Road between I-15 and Business Park Avenue from a 4-Lane Major Street to a 4-Lane Prime Street on the Proposed Circulation Element Map; and

WHEREAS, on June 28, 2012, the Planning Commission of the City of San Diego considered the Community Plan Amendment, and voted 5-0-2 to recommend City Council approval of the Community Plan Amendment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has considered the Planning Commission record as well as all maps, exhibits, and written documents contained in the file for this project on record in the City of San Diego, and has considered the oral presentations given at the public hearing; NOW, THEREFORE,
