A RESOLUTION DENYING AN APPEAL AND UPHOLDING THE ENVIRONMENTAL DETERMINATION FOR THE WESTFIELD UTC COMPREHENSIVE SIGN PLAN PROJECT (PROJECT NO. 289311)

WHEREAS, Westfield UTC submitted an application for a Neighborhood Use Permit for a comprehensive sign plan for the Westfield UTC shopping center (project); and

WHEREAS, on November 20, 2012, the City of San Diego (City) determined the project to be exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 (Existing Facilities) and a Notice of Right to Appeal Environmental Determination was posted; and

WHEREAS, on December 5, 2012, Linda Colley filed an Environmental Determination Appeal Application (Appeal) with the City's Development Services Department stating that the project is not an existing facility, is not a minor alteration, and does not involve a negligible expansion of use, and would result in aesthetic and lighting impacts; and

WHEREAS, the Appeal was heard before the City Council on March 11, 2013; and WHEREAS, the project would not result in any additional use of the shopping center; and

WHEREAS, the project involves new copy on existing on and off-premise signs; and WHEREAS, the project would involve a reallocation of square footage, and would not increase the maximum allowable sign copy area at the shopping center; and

WHEREAS, approval of the project would not result in a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the project meets the criteria set forth in CEQA Guidelines Sections 15301;

WHEREAS, under Charter section 280(a)(2) this resolution is not subject to veto by the
