A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE AGREEMENT WITH HDR ENGINEERING, INC. FOR AS-NEEDED CONSULTANT SERVICES FOR WASTEWATER FACILITIES CONDITION ASSESSMENT IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15262.

WHEREAS, the City's Public Utilities Department desires to enter into an agreement with HDR Engineering, Inc. (HDR) for consulting services to be provided on an as-needed basis for the assessment of the condition of the City's wastewater facilities, for a term of three years and with a value not to exceed \$5,000,000 (Agreement), and this Agreement will allow the City to collect condition related data and facilitate future work to repair, replace or upgrade wastewater facilities in a cost-effective manner; and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, CEQA section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260-15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, after having considered the written record concerning the Agreement as well as public comment, if any, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has determined based

upon its independent judgment that CEQA Guidelines section 15262 covers the Agreement;


NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Agreement is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15262.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Exemption with the Clerk of the County of San Diego.




