A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING A STREET NAME CHANGE FOR A PORTION OF CARMEL MOUNTAIN ROAD TO DEL VINO COURT - STREET NAME CHANGE NO. 1018174 – PROJECT NO. 290143.

WHEREAS, Section 34091.1 of the California Government Code authorizes the City Council to change the name of City streets by resolution, and Council Policy 600-12 provides a process by which street names may be changed upon petition of affected property owners; and

WHEREAS, currently, Carmel Mountain Road transitions into Del Vino Court approximately at the intersection of Carmel Mountain Road and Little Mcgonigle Ranch Road; and

WHEREAS, the applicant has requested permission to relocate that transition point approximately one mile south because it believes that location would be a more logical transition point; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with Council Policy 600-12, 100 percent of the property owners on this portion of Carmel Mountain Road have expressed support for the street name change; and

WHEREAS, the Del Mar Mesa Community Planning Association supports the street name change; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the name of a portion of Carmel Mountain Road, more particularly shown on Drawing No. 37156-1 & -2 B, attached hereto as Exhibit "A," is changed to Del Vino Court.

2. That the City Clerk shall cause a certified copy of this resolution, with Exhibit "A," attested under seal, to be recorded in the Office of the County Recorder.
