WHEREAS, Council District 2 recommends an allocation of \$5,525 to The Mission Hills Business Improvement District for the purposes set forth herein; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation described herein is made for a public purpose.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby waives Council Policy 100-06, section 3(g) which provides that an organization may not apply to receive funding for an event or program which has already occurred, nor any capital improvement; goods, supplies, materials, or equipment which have already been purchased.
