A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE DEFERRED CAPITAL PROJECTS REALLOCATION OF FUNDS IS EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15061(b)(3).

WHEREAS, this action will revise and reallocate the funding for various Capital Projects financed through Deferred Capital Bond Funds; and

WHEREAS, while the underlying projects to this action have a potential to result in a physical change to the environment, this action will neither commit the City to construct any of the listed projects nor authorize the expenditure of funds in furtherance of any of the listed projects; and

WHEREAS, the individual projects subject to this action are subject to subsequent discretionary approvals where a project specific environmental review would be more meaningful; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of this reallocation of Deferred Capital Bond Funds; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Deferred Capital Reallocation of Funds is exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15061(b)(3).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.


