A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE CONTRACT WITH CONTEMPORARY DESIGN LANDSCAPE AND RELATED EXPENDITURES FOR LANDSCAPE MAINTENANCE SERVICES WITHIN THE STONECREST VILLAGE MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego's Park and Recreation Department, Open Space

Division, currently administers 49 of the 56 Maintenance Assessment Districts ("MADs")

located throughout the City, including the Stonecrest Village Maintenance Assessment District

("Stonecrest Village MAD"); and

WHEREAS, the Stonecrest Village MAD was established on March 4, 1997 per Resolution No. R-288402 to maintain landscaped medians, parkways, greenbelts, slopes, ornate street lights, decorative sign posts, and pavers within a residential subdivision located along West Canyon Avenue, Daley Center Drive, and Stonecrest Boulevard; and

WHEREAS, the Stonecrest Village MAD also maintains a paved asphalt trail, connecting trails, and open space areas within the residential subdivision; and

WHEREAS, all landscape maintenance activities in the Stonecrest Village MAD are provided by landscape contractor; and

WHEREAS, following a competitive selection and procurement process, the City selected Contemporary Design Landscape as the lowest responsible bidder and City Council authorized a contract with Contemporary Design Landscape for landscape maintenance activities within the Stonecrest Village MAD ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on May 14,2013, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the landscape maintenance activities in the Stonecrest Village MAD merely includes care and cleaning of existing street medians, parkway landscaping, sidewalks, curbs and gutters, landscaped slopes, greenbelts, and open space easement areas; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
