A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING A SURPLUS IN THE LA JOLLA MESA VISTA UNDERGROUND UTILITY ASSESSMENT DISTRICT FUND.

WHEREAS, property owners in the La Jolla Mesa Vista neighborhood desired to have their utilities undergrounded in advance of the City's Undergrounding Master Plan; and

WHEREAS, the La Jolla Mesa Vista community initiated a petition to create a special assessment district under the Municipal Improvement Act of 1913; and

WHEREAS, the City Council certified the creation of an assessment district and approved an assessment of \$690,412.00 to be levied upon 56 parcels within the La Jolla Vista Mesa community for the purposes of undergrounding overhead utilities; and

WHEREAS, the engineers estimate to complete the project was \$1,096,222.00 of which \$25,810 in funding was contributed by assessment district residents, \$690,412.00 was from the assessment, and \$380,000 was contributed by the City's Utilities Undergrounding Program; and

WHEREAS, the La Jolla Mesa Vista undergrounding project was completed in December 2012 at a total cost of \$970,339.29 with a resulting surplus of \$125,882.71; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. Declaring surplus funds in the La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Utility
Assessment District, Fund 200502 La Jolla Mesa Vista, in the amount of \$125,882.71, as
outlined within the California Street and Highways Code § 10427, which was originally

established for the purpose of the accelerated undergrounding of overhead utilities within the La

Jolla Community Planning Area.

2. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$125,882.71 from Fund 200502,

La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Utility Assessment District Fund, is hereby authorized, solely

and exclusively, for the purposes of the administration and return of monies to the person or

persons owning the assessed property, as outlined within the California Street Highways Codes

§§ 10427(b) and 10427.1(b), contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or

more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with

the City Treasurer.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to transfer, an amount not to exceed

\$1,000 from Fund 200502, La Jolla Mesa Vista Underground Utility Assessment District Fund to

Fund 200217, Utilities Underground Fund, as provided by California Street and Highways Code

§ 10427(a), for the sole purpose of closing out the Fund.
