A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE MISSION CENTER ROAD AT SAN DIEGO RIVER BIKE PATH IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT AND THE MICROWAVE BICYCLE DETECTION – INTERSECTOR PROJECTS ARE CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINE SECTION 15301 FOR EXISTING FACILITIES.

WHEREAS, this action will increase the CIP budgets, and authorize the expenditure of SANDAG Active Transportation Grant Funding for the Mission Center Road at San Diego River Bike Path Improvement Project and the Microwave Bicycle Detection – Intersector Projects; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Mission Center Road at San Diego River Bike Path Improvements

Project and the Microwave Bicycle Detection – Intersector Projects; and

WHEREAS, on May 21, 2013, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the projects will not have a significant effect on the environment as both projects are minor alterations to existing bicycle transportation facilities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that both the Mission Center Road at San Diego River Bike Path Improvements Project and the Microwave Detection – Intersector Projects are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
