A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE CONTRACT WITH HAAKER EQUIPMENT COMPANY FOR PURCHASE OF SEWER MAIN CLEANING TRUCKS; AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Public Utilities Department, Wastewater Collection Division

(Department), utilizes vacuum/flushing trucks to clean and maintain the wastewater collection pipeline system; and

WHEREAS, the Department plans to replace up to twenty sewer main cleaning trucks as their usable life expires over the next several years, at an estimated combined cost of \$8 to \$10 million; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a contract (Contract) with Haaker Equipment Company for the purchase of vacuum/flushing sewer main cleaning trucks in quantities as may be required for a period of one year for an amount not to exceed \$1,766,046.37 and with four options to renew for four additional 1-year periods with allowable price escalations not to exceed 10 percent of the prices in effect for the previous year, under the terms and conditions set forth in RFB No. 10023129-13-E, a copy of which document is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 308229
- 2. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to exercise, for and on behalf of the City, the four options to renew the Contract for additional 1-year periods, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Contract, provided that the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one

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or more certificates demonstrating that the funds for the expenditures are, or will be, on deposit

with the City Treasury.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an

amount not to exceed \$1,766,046.37 from Fund 720013, Vehicle Replacement Fund for the

purpose of funding the first year of the Contract, provided that the Chief Financial Officer first

furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds for the expenditure are, or will be,

on deposit with the City Treasury.

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend amounts

from Fund 720013, Vehicle Replacement Fund for each renewed Contract option year, provided

that escalation in prices, if any, do not exceed 10 percent of the prior year's prices and further

provided that the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating

that the funds for the expenditures are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasury.
