- 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 over 3 years for the purpose of funding the As-Needed Professional Construction Management Services Agreement with SAIC Energy, Environmental & Infrastructure contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing a certificate demonstrating that funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasury.

- 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend \$1,000 from CIP S-00322, Metropolitan Biosolids Center Additional Biosolids Storage Silos 9 and 10, Fund 700009, for the purpose of executing this agreement and meeting minimum contract requirements and, funding for future tasks will be funded by the CIP projects requiring these services contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer furnishing a certificate demonstrating the funds are, or will be on deposit with the City Treasury.
- 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
