A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN
DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION TO STATE OF
CALIFORNIA TO UPDATE THE TARGETED EMPLOYMENT
AREA FOR THE SAN DIEGO REGIONAL ENTERPRISE ZONE

WHEREAS, the City Council adopted Resolution No. R-301845 effective August 15, 2006, authorizing submission of an application to the State of California Housing and Community Development Department (HCD) for a San Diego Regional Enterprise Zone (SDREZ) designation including the cities of San Diego, Chula Vista and National City (Co-Applicants), and directing the Mayor or his designee to execute the necessary documents and agreements related to the application process; and

WHEREAS, the Co-Applicants have an approved Targeted Employment Area (TEA) incorporating eligible low and moderate income 2010 Census Tracts within the cities of San Diego, Chula Vista, and National City as designated areas approved by HCD to encourage Enterprise Zone business to hire TEA residents and therefore receive state tax credits on wages paid to these employees; and


WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego adopted Resolution No. R-304080 effective September 10, 2008, authorizing the Mayor to submit an application to HCD establishing the TEA; and

WHEREAS, the California Enterprise Zone Act requires each Enterprise Zone jurisdiction to update TEA boundaries as new United States census data is made available and to approve by resolution or ordinance the updated boundaries by its governing body; and

WHEREAS, the Co-Applicants shall submit an application for a new TEA incorporating eligible low and moderate income Census Tracts based on the most recent census data available as set forth in the map attached as Exhibit A to the Item Summary accompanying this Resolution (Census Map) and the eligible Census Tract table attached as Exhibit B to the Item Summary accompanying this Resolution (Census Table), which is geographically consistent with the State TEA eligibility criteria so as to maximize job creation opportunities for SDREZ businesses that hire TEA residents so they can receive state tax credits on wages paid to these employees; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council supports and authorizes the Mayor or designee to submit the application to HCD establishing a new TEA for the SDREZ consistent with the information set forth in the Census Map and the Census Table attached as Exhibits A and B, respectively, to the Item Summary accompanying this Resolution.


