A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DECLARING THE COUNCIL'S INTENTION TO CONTINUE THE LEVY AND COLLECTION OF ANNUAL ASSESSMENTS WITHIN EACH OF THE SPECIFIED CITY-MANAGED MAINTENANCE ASSESSMENT DISTRICTS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2014 AND NOTICING THE PUBLIC HEARING.

WHEREAS, the City forms each Maintenance Assessment District ("MAD") pursuant to Article XIIID of the California Constitution, the Proposition 218 Omnibus Implementation Act (California Government Code section 53750 et seq.), the Landscape and Lighting Act of 1972 (California Streets and Highways Code section 22500 et seq.), and the Maintenance Assessment Districts Ordinance (San Diego Municipal Code section 65.0201 et seq.); and

WHEREAS, as part of the formation process, an assessment engineer prepared written reports ("Engineer's Reports") for each of the City's MADs; and

WHEREAS, the City Council preliminarily approved the updated Engineer's Reports for each of the following City-managed MADs for the period of July 1, 2013 through June 30, 2014 ("Fiscal Year 2014"):

The improvements and activities within these MADs generally consists of construction and maintenance of landscaped and paved medians, landscaped right-of-ways and slopes, open space, parks, ponds, flood control channels, monuments, decorative street lighting, decorative gates, community signage, banners, curbs and gutters, and sidewalks, as well as the provision of security services.
- 3. Each City-managed MAD is generally located in the following Community Planning Area ("CPA"):

- 5. The assessments for the following MADs are proposed to be adjusted downward: Carmel Valley Neighborhood 10, Coronado View, Ocean View Hills, Pacific Highlands Ranch, and Torrey Hills.
- 6. The assessments for the following City-managed MADs are proposed to be adjusted upward, but not by more than the formula specified in the original Engineer's Report allows: Bay Terraces Parkside, Camino Santa Fe, Carmel Mountain Ranch, El Cajon Boulevard, First San Diego River Project (FSDRIP), Gateway Center East, Kings Row and Village at Euclid Zone 2, North Park, Otay International Center, Peñasquitos East, Rancho Bernardo, Remington Hills, Robinhood Ridge, Scripps-Miramar Ranch, Street Lighting District #1, Talmadge, Tierrasanta, Torrey Highlands, University Heights, and Washington Street;
- 7. The assessments for the remaining City-managed MADs are proposed to stay the same as in Fiscal Year 2013.
- 8. Notice is hereby given that July 16, 2013, at 2:00 p.m., or as soon thereafter as it may be heard, in the Council Chambers of the City Administration Building, located at 202 "C" Street, 12th Floor, San Diego, California, is fixed as the time and place when and where any and all interested persons having a desire to be heard may appear and state their views, and/or submit written protests in compliance with California Streets and Highways Code section 22628.
