A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE AGREEMENT WITH ARCADIS U.S., INC. FOR ASBESTOS CEMENT WATER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROGRAM MASTER PLAN (CONTRACT NUMBER H125808) IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15262.

WHEREAS, the City's Public Utilities - Water Department desires to enter into an agreement with Arcadis U.S., Inc. (Arcadis) to develop a system-wide Asbestos Cement (AC) Water Main Replacement Program Master Plan (Contract Number H125808) (Agreement) which will not exceed \$1,998,580 to begin in Fiscal Year 2014 (FY 2014) and end in FY 2016. The services include assessing over 2,100 miles of AC water mains which include: estimating life expectancy of AC pipes, determining overall risk level of water mains by applying a statistical model using risk analysis, and field sample analysis data to determine the criticality of AC pipes. The ultimate goal is to identify pipeline replacement priority based on criticality and financial requirements; and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, CEQA section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260-15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, after having considered the written record concerning the Agreement as well as public comment, if any, the Council of the City of San Diego (Council) has determined based upon its independent judgment that CEQA Guidelines section 15262 covers the Agreement; NOW, THEREFORE.

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Agreement is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15262 (feasibility and planning studies).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Exemption with the Clerk of the County of San Diego.
