A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT FOR THE MUSEUM OF MAN ROOF REPLACEMENT PHASE II PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTIONS 15301 (EXISTING FACILITIES) AND 15331 (HISTORICAL RESOURCE RESTORATION/REHABILITATION).

WHEREAS, on February 27, 2008, the City of San Diego entered into Agreement

No. HO84193 with Heritage Architecture & Planning (Consultant) for the Museum of Man Roof

Replacement Project (Project) to provide architectural and engineering design and support; and

WHEREAS, during construction of the Project, the Project team discovered that the

North East Dome had shifted off its base causing hollow areas within its base perimeter; and

WHEREAS, once the Museum of Man roof and dome structures were repaired, the

Project team diverted its attention to the interior of the museum (ceilings and walls) and exhibits,

which were damaged over the years by the leaky roof; and

WHEREAS, to address the dome issues and the interior damage, the Consultant was required to prepare plans and specifications to repair those damages prior to construction; and

WHEREAS, this Amendment will compensate the Consultant for all work necessary to ensure this Project addressed all structural and interior issues discovered during construction; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects

which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300 through 15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 (Existing Facilities) and section 15331 (Historical Resource Restoration/Rehabilitation) and that no exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the Project; and

WHEREAS, on _______, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because the scope of work is limited to the repair of an existing structure which involves no expansion of an existing use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301 and 15331.

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Exemption regarding the Project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego.
