A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF A FIRST AMENDMENT TO AN AGREEMENT WITH GL NOBLE DENTON, INC. FOR WATER MODELING PROFESSIONAL CONSULTING SERVICES.

WHEREAS, on March 15, 2011, the Public Utilities Department [Department] via San Diego Data Processing Corporation [SDDPC] conducted a competitive bid process and issued a request for proposal for software and water modeling professional consulting services; and

WHEREAS, three firms were interviewed and GL Noble Denton [GL Noble] was selected and a Master Service Contract [Agreement] was executed between GL Noble and SDDPC; and

WHEREAS, GL Noble professional consulting services are used to provide specialized technical services in the areas such as water model calibration, water model system status advisor intranet web application enhancements, creating water quality on-line analysis and pump station energy calculations; and

WHEREAS, as a result of the City's Information Technology Services outsourcing, the GL Noble Agreement was assigned to the City from SDDPC effective January 1, 2012 and this First Amendment adds standard City provisions and provides that the term of the Agreement will not extend for more than five years without approval by ordinance of the Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to award and execute, for and on

behalf of the City, the First Amendment to the Agreement with GL Noble under the terms and

conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No.

RR 308323, to provide water modeling professional consulting services, in an amount not

to exceed \$1,180,000, for the duration of four (4) years, contingent upon adoption of the Annual

Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable fiscal year, and contingent upon City Comptroller

furnishing one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be,

on deposit with the City Treasurer.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed

\$1,180,000 from the Water Operating Fund 700011, for the purpose of funding the above

Agreement, contingent upon adoption of the Annual Appropriation Ordinance for the applicable

fiscal year, and contingent upon City Comptroller furnishing one or more certificates certifying

that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
