A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE SALE OF CITY-OWNED LAND TO BALDWIN & SONS, LLC (VILLAGE 2), RESERVATION OF EASEMENT AND ACQUISITION OF ACCESS EASEMENTS IN CHULA VISTA IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15312.

WHEREAS, the City has entered into a Real Estate Purchase and Sale Agreement, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. **Act 308335**, with Baldwin & Sons, LLC, a California limited liability company, for the sale of that certain real property consisting of approximately 11.32 acres of land identified as Assessor's Parcel Number 644-313-09, located in Chula Vista, California (Property), reserving an easement on the Property for existing City water pipelines under the Property, and acquisition of access easements on that certain real property identified as Assessor's Parcel Numbers 644-310-41 and 644-311-18, and a portion of Assessor's Parcel Number 644-311-17 (Project); and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA) (Public Resources Code section 21000 et seq.), section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines thereto (California Code of Regulations, Title 14, Chapter 3, Section 15000 et seq.) shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research and adopted by the Secretary of the California Natural Resources Agency for those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the Project is

categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15312 and that no

exception to the exemption, as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2, applies to the

Project; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the

written record for the Project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has

determined that the Project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it is the

sale of surplus government property with the reservation of an easement and the acquisition of an

access easement, and no physical changes to the property are contemplated by this transaction;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego determines that the Project

is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15312 and that an

exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
