A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO SUPPORTING THE 2013 MCAS MIRAMAR AIR SHOW

WHEREAS, the Marine Corps Air Station (MCAS) Miramar Air Show is a longtime civic event that has been held in San Diego for the past fifty-seven years; and

WHEREAS, sequestration has resulted in the Department of Defense issuing the cancellation of military air shows across the country; and

WHEREAS, MCAS Miramar has not yet received a waiver from the Secretary of Defense to authorize the 58th Annual Miramar Air Show, which is scheduled to be held October 4, 2013 to October 6, 2013; and

WHEREAS, San Diego County is home to MCAS Miramar, MCB Camp Pendleton, MCRD San Diego, Naval Base Point Loma, Naval Base San Diego, Space and Naval Warfare Systems Center San Diego, Space and Naval Warfare Systems Command San Diego, Naval Station North Island, Naval Amphibious Base Coronado, Silver Strand Training Complex, Outlying Field Imperial Beach, and the Naval Medical Center San Diego, and thus the impact and role the military plays in San Diego County is extremely significant; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Military Advisory Council (SDMAC) states that the military's shift in strategic focus to the Asia Pacific region will continue to support the Navy's presence in San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the military serves as one of the strongest economic engines for the region, with defense-related activities and spending generating more than \$32 billion in gross regional product in fiscal year 2012 alone, according to the SDMAC; and

WHEREAS, the SDMAC reports that the military sector was responsible for more than 311,000 jobs in the region in 2012, representing one in four jobs in the San Diego regional economy; and

WHEREAS, San Diego's numerous military personnel, contractors and subcontractors are vital to the local economy; and

WHEREAS, the military directly spent \$20.6 billion in the San Diego region in 2012, according to Navy Region Southwest; and

WHEREAS, due to the scope and size of the sequestration cuts over the next decade, these companies and their employees will be significantly impacted by cuts to military operations, acquisition and technology development; and

WHEREAS, the draconian cuts to military related jobs, implemented by a flawed policy of sequestration, are detrimental to the San Diego economy; and

WHEREAS, this policy must be revisited by Congress in a manner that does not hurt local economies and impact jobs as San Diego continues to recover from multiple years of recession; and

WHEREAS, the Miramar Air Show is generally attended by more than 500,000 military personnel, families, and civilians annually, with nearly half of the attendees traveling more than 30 miles to the show, according to the MCAS Miramar Air Show website; and

WHEREAS, the MCAS Miramar Air Show is a key component to San Diego's Fleet

Week; and

WHEREAS, the overall impact of the MCAS Miramar Air Show is as much as

\$17 million in direct and indirect spending within the San Diego regional economy, according to

the SDMAC; and

WHEREAS, revenue derived from the Miramar Air Show is used for important support

services for MCAS Miramar, funding much-needed programs including child care, lodging, and

the mental and physical well-being of troops; and

WHEREAS, cancelling the MCAS Miramar Air Show would negatively impact the

economy and military morale, and be counterproductive to military outreach in the region;

NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego strongly supports the

MCAS Miramar Air Show and encourages the Secretary of Defense to take all necessary actions

to restore funding to allow the 58th Annual Miramar Air Show to take place on its scheduled

dates of October 4, 2013 through October 6, 2013.
