A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT ACCEPTING FUNDS FROM HIGHWAY SAFETY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM FOR THE ULRIC STREET FASHION HILLS TO DAVID STREET, K-RAIL PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO EXEMPTION 15301.

WHEREAS, Transportation Engineering staff proposed the installation of a concrete barrier in the center of the road, installation of sidewalk on the east side of Ulric Street, and installation of pedestrian ramps to meet ADA standards; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the construction on Ulric Street Fashion Hills to David Street, K-rail; and

WHEREAS, on ____JUL 15 2013 ___, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it involves a minor alteration to existing facilities with negligible or no expansion of use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the construction on Ulric Street Fashion Hills to David Street, K-rail is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
