A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO PURSUANT TO SECTION 147(f) OF THE INTERNAL REVENUE CODE OF 1986 APPROVING THE ISSUANCE OF BONDS BY THE HOUSING AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO FOR THE WAKELAND/ CITY HEIGHTS SCATTERED SITES APARTMENTS

WHEREAS, the Housing Authority of the City of San Diego (Authority) intends to issue not to exceed \$8,000,000 aggregate principal amount of multifamily housing revenue bonds (Bonds) to finance the acquisition, rehabilitation and equipping of several multifamily rental housing facilities in the City of San Diego (City) described in the notice of public hearing attached as Exhibit A hereto (Projects); and

WHEREAS, in order for interest on the Bonds to be tax-exempt, Section 147(f) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986 requires that the Bonds be approved by the City Council as the applicable elected representative after a public hearing following reasonable public notice; and

WHEREAS, notice of a public hearing with respect to the proposed issuance of the Bonds was published in a newspaper of general circulation in the City on August 20, 2013; and

WHEREAS, the public hearing was held on September 10, 2013, and an opportunity was provided for interested persons to express their views on the issuance of the Bonds and on the nature and location of the Projects; and

WHEREAS, under Charter section 265(i), resolutions adopted by the City Council are not subject to veto pending an election to fill the vacancy in the Office of the Mayor, but the Council President, serving as the interim Mayor during the period of vacancy, generally has the

authority to approve resolutions in circumstances where expeditious approval is necessary to meet a legal requirement imposed by a court or another governmental agency; and

WHEREAS, the officers and/or the program managers of the Authority must file an application to the California Debt Limit Allocation Committee (CDLAC) for an allocation from the state ceiling of private activity bonds to be issued by the Authority for the Projects by September 13, 2013, which application must include a copy of this Resolution to evidence that the required Tax Equity and Fiscal Responsibility Act public hearing was held; and

WHEREAS, in light of these circumstances, it is requested that the Council President approve this Resolution expeditiously so that it will become effective in time to be included in the application to be filed with CDLAC on or before September 13, 2013; and

WHEREAS, all references to the "Mayor" in this Resolution are intended to refer to the elected Mayor or the interim Mayor, as may be applicable upon the occurrence of each authorized action item; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego that this City Council, as the applicable elected representative under Section 147(f) of the Code, approves the issuance of the Bonds by the Authority.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City does not warrant the creditworthiness of the Bonds or guarantee, in any way, the payment of the Bonds. No moneys of the City will be pledged or applied to the repayment of the Bonds.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the acquisition, rehabilitation and equipping of the Projects is categorically exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act under Sections 15301 (Existing Facilities) and 15332 (In-Fill Development Projects).

Processing under the National Environmental Policy Act is not required, as no federal funds are involved in this action.
