A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO APPROVING THE FISCAL YEAR 2014 EAST ELLIOTT PUBLIC FACILITIES FINANCING PLAN AND DEVELOPMENT IMPACT FEE SCHEDULE.

WHEREAS, Pardee Homes filed an application to obtain approvals from the City of San Diego for a residential development known as the Castlerock project in the East Elliott Community Plan Area abutting the City of Santee; and

WHEREAS, the Castlerock project has two possible scenarios: (1) the Annexation Scenario, which would allow development of 430 residential units with annexation to the City of Santee, and (2) the No Annexation Scenario, which would allow development of 422 residential units to remain in the jurisdiction of the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ordinance No. O- 20305 (approving a Vesting Tentative Map for the Castlerock Project No. 10046) and Ordinance No. O- 20304 (approving a Site Development Permit for the Castlerock Project No. 10046), the approvals for the Castlerock project are not effective until the Local Agency Formation Commission makes a final determination whether to grant or deny the proposed annexation; and

WHEREAS, the Council has reviewed and considered the methodology set forth in the Fiscal Year 2014 East Elliott Public Facilities Financing Plan and Development Impact Fee Schedule (FY 2014 East Elliott Financing Plan), on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 308435; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. The FY 2014 East Elliott Financing Plan is approved, subject to the approvals for the No Annexation Scenario for the Castlerock project taking effect as set forth in Section 8 of Ordinance No. 0 20304 and Section 9 of Ordinance No. 0 20304.
- 2. That subject to the FY 2014 East Elliott Financing Plan becoming effective, the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish and modify individual Capital Improvement Program project budgets to reflect the FY 2014 East Elliott Financing Plan provided funding is available for such action.
- 3. That subject to the FY 2014 East Elliott Financing Plan becoming effective, effective on the date the approvals for the No Annexation Scenario for the Castlerock project take effect as set forth in Section 8 of Ordinance No. 20304 and Section 9 of Ordinance No. 20304 or sixty days from the date of final passage of this resolution, whichever occurs later, all development impact fees due under the FY 2014 East Elliott Financing Plan, shall be those fees in effect at the time building permits are issued, plus automatic annual increases in accordance with San Diego Municipal Code section 142.0640(b).
- 4. That the FY 2014 East Elliott Financing Plan, is incorporated by reference into this Resolution as support and justification for satisfaction of findings required pursuant to the Mitigation Fee Act, as set forth in California Government Code section 66000 et seq., for imposition of development impact fees. Specifically, it is determined and found that this documentation:
- a. Identifies the purpose of the development impact fee, which is to ensure that new development projects pay a proportionate share of funding needed for community serving infrastructure necessary to serve new development;

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Identifies the use to which the development impact fee is to be put. The b.

development impact fees will be used to finance library facilities as set forth in the FY 2014 East

Elliott Financing Plan;

Demonstrates how there is a reasonable relationship between the c.

development impact fee use and the type of development project on which the development

impact fee is imposed. The development impact fees will be used to provide library

infrastructure needed to serve residential development.

Demonstrates how there is a reasonable relationship between the need for d.

the public facility and the type of development project on which the development impact fee is

imposed. Residential development utilizes the community's libraries, and improvements are

necessary based on the projected population at full community development to maintain existing

levels of service, and to achieve General Plan standards.
