A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE INSTALLATION OF COMMUNITY SIGNS ON BALBOA AVENUE TO THE EAST OF INTERSTATE 805 AND TO THE WEST OF INTERSTATE 15 IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO SECTION 15301.

WHEREAS, the State of California will relinquish the median on Balboa Avenue east of Interstate 805 to the City of San Diego, in order for the City to construct a community sign in the median; and

WHEREAS, the City will install a second community sign on Balboa Avenue to the west of Interstate 15; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the relinquishment of the median on Balboa Avenue just east of Interstate 805, and the installation of two community signs; and

WHEREAS, on 10/15/2013, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it involves a minor alteration to an existing public facility with negligible or no expansion of use; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the relinquishment of the median on Balboa Avenue just east of Interstate 805 and the installation of two community signs are categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Exemption regarding the project with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego.
