A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE APPROVAL OF THE AGREEMENT FOR RECREATIONAL IMPROVEMENTS TO CHICANO PARK IS STATUTORILY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO CEQA GUIDELINES SECTION 15262.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego desires to enter into a contract with Urban Corps of San Diego for recreational improvements to Chicano Park (Project); and

WHEREAS, the contract includes planning, engineering, design, and construction; and WHEREAS, the City's park design process includes input and workshops with the public and there is no design for the park presently that would allow for any meaningful review for impacts to the environment pursuant to the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA); and

WHEREAS, the California State Legislature, through CEQA, Public Resources Code sections 21000-21177, has determined that CEQA does not apply to various types of projects listed therein; and

WHEREAS, CEQA section 21084 states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of Projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15260-15285 list the statutory exemptions promulgated by the California State Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Development Services Department has established that the portion of the Project that relates to planning and design is statutorily exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15262; and

WHEREAS, the contract with Urban Corps specifically requires that prior to final

approval of a proposed site plan and general development plan for Chicano Park, Urban Corps

must conduct any required environmental review and obtain any necessary permits; and

WHEREAS, the above provision will allow for environmental review to be conducted at

a time when meaningful information is available to allow for review, pursuant to CEQA

Guidelines section 15004; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential

environmental effects of the Project, and

WHEREAS, on OCT 2 2 2013 \_\_\_\_, the City Council held a duly noticed public

meeting and considered the written record for the Project as well as any public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has

determined that the planning and design portions of the Project will not have a significant effect

on the environment and that any design is subject to CEQA review and permitting prior to

approval; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that the portions of the Project that relate to planning and design are

statutorily exempt from CEOA pursuant to CEOA Guidelines section 15262.
