A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING \$5,000 TO SCRIPPS MESA FIREWORKS, INC. FOR THE SCRIPPS MESA 4th OF JULY FIREWORK SHOW, PURSUANT TO COUNCIL POLICY 100-23, "CITY COUNCIL FUNDING OF ARTS, CULTURE AND COMMUNITY FESTIVALS WITH DISCRETIONARY TRANSIENT OCCUPANCY TAX ALLOCATION."

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council (City Council) adopted Council Policy 100-23, entitled "City Council Funding of Arts, Culture and Community Festivals with Transient Occupancy Tax Allocation" on August 13, 2012, by Resolution R-307625; and

WHEREAS, among other things, Council Policy 100-23 provides a procedure and uniform requirements for awarding funds to and contracting with private nonprofit organizations that produce programs, projects and events that (i) provide access to excellence in culture and the arts for residents of, and visitors to, San Diego, and (ii) enrich the lives of the people of San Diego and build healthy, vital neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, Scripps Mesa Fireworks, Inc. (SMFI) has requested funding for the Scripps Mesa 4th of July Fireworks Show whereat attendees will enjoy an event that pulls members of the entire Mira Mesa and multiple other communities together to celebrate freedom, patriotism, and fireworks artistry (Project); and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the Project fits within the parameters of Council Policy 100-23; and

WHEREAS, Council District 6 recommends an allocation of \$5,000 to SMFI for the purposes set forth herein; NOW, THEREFORE,

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BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the allocation

described herein will assist SMFI in producing the Project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council hereby waives section 3(g) of Council

Policy 100-23, which provides that an organization may not apply to receive funding for an event

or program which has already occurred, nor any goods, supplies or materials which have already

been purchased.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council President in his capacity under Charter

section 265(i), or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the

City, an agreement with SMFI in an amount not to exceed \$5,000 for the Project, in accordance

with the terms and conditions set forth in the agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend

an amount not to exceed \$5,000 from the Transient Occupancy Tax Fund No. 200205, Cost

Center 1414111217, to provide funds for the above-referenced agreement, contingent upon the

City Comptroller first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for

expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
