A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION, ACCEPTANCE, APPROPRIATION, AND EXPENDITURE OF \$261,042 IN FY 2013 STATE HOMELAND SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING.

WHEREAS, State Homeland Security Grant Program (SHSP) funds are issued annually by the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA); and

WHEREAS, all fifty states, the District of Columbia, and designated territories are eligible to apply for FY 2013 SHSP funds; and

WHEREAS, the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services applied directly to FEMA for FY 2013 SHSP funds of behalf of California agencies and local jurisdictions; and

WHEREAS, FY 2013 SHSP funds were allocated by FEMA based on the following three factors: 1) minimum amounts as legislatively mandated, 2) the United States Department of Homeland Security's risk methodology, and 3) anticipated effectiveness of the proposed grant projects; and

WHEREAS, FEMA passes the allocated SHSP funds through the State of California to the County of San Diego (County); and

WHEREAS, the County allocates a portion of the funds to the City according to the City's number of sworn budgeted law enforcement officers; and

WHEREAS, the City's allocation of FY 2013 SHSP funds is \$261,042; and

WHEREAS, the SHSP supports the implementation of homeland security strategies to enhance capabilities to prevent, protect against, mitigate, respond to, and recover from acts of terrorism and other catastrophic events; and

WHEREAS, SHSP also provides funding to implement initiatives in the State Preparedness Report; and

WHEREAS, SHSP funded projects and activities must address identified planning, organization, equipment, training, and exercise the needs of the City, and these activities must be approved by FEMA, the State of California, and the County prior to the expenditure of grant funds; and

WHEREAS, the City's Office of Homeland Security (OHS) will serve as the agent for the City to receive and expend the FY 2013 funds; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department (SDPD) developed, and OHS submitted, a grant expenditure plan to procure equipment to strengthen SDPD's capabilities in interoperable communications, information technology, physical security for critical infrastructure, tactical response to terrorism incidents, and search and rescue; and

WHEREAS, there is no non-federal match or cost share required for participation in the SHSP; and

WHEREAS, this grant is reimbursable in nature, requiring the City to expend funds prior to requesting reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, expenditures will be initially sourced from the City's General Fund, and then reimbursed from FY 0213 SHSP funding; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council President acting pursuant to Charter Section 265(i), or his designee, is authorized and directed to apply for and accept \$261,042 in FY 2013 State Homeland Security Grant Program

Grant #1000031-2013 funding from the California Governor's Office of Emergency Services via

the County of San Diego Office of Emergency Services, as the City's authorized agent, and to execute all agreements necessary to comply with the grant requirements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to appropriate and expend \$261,042 in FY 2013 State Homeland Security Grant ency ized
