A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO CONFIRMING APPOINTMENTS TO THE CITIZENS EQUAL OPPORTUNITY COMMISSION

WHEREAS, the San Diego City Council adopted an ordinance, codified at San Diego Municipal Code section 26.16, establishing the Citizens Equal Opportunity Commission; and

WHEREAS, section 26.16 provides that the Commission monitor and/or evaluate the City's Equal Opportunity Program; advise the Mayor, City Council, Civil Service Commission and other appropriate agencies; submit written quarterly reports for review by the City Council's Rules Committee and the City Council; assist in recruiting competent, historically underrepresented minorities, women and disabled to compete for City positions; and promote the City of San Diego as an Equal Opportunity Employer of individuals and firms desiring to contract with the City; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that the Commission shall consist of 11 members appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that the board shall include one representative from each of the following historically underrepresented groups: Latino, African-American, Filipino, American Indian, Asian/Pacific Islander, Disabled and Lesbian/Gay/Bisexual/Transgender [LGBT]; and

WHEREAS, the ordinance provides that members shall serve two-year terms; each member shall serve until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed; and all terms must have expiration dates of January 1; and

WHEREAS, the Council now seeks to fill five positions on the Commission; and WHEREAS, the Commission is a Charter section 43 advisory board and the Council is filling vacancies on the board under the authority granted to it in Charter section 43(c); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointments by the Council of the City of San Diego, in compliance with San Diego Charter section 43(c), to serve as members of the Citizens Equal Opportunity Commission, for terms expiring as indicated, are made and hereby confirmed:
