A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMING THAT THE TRANSFER OF FUNDS TO TED WILLIAMS PARKWAY OVERCROSSING AT SHOALCREEK DRIVE PROJECT IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO EXEMPTION GUIDELINE 15301 AND 15303.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) seeks to reallocate excess TransNet funds to the Ted Williams Parkway Overcrossing at Shoal Creek Drive Project; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego (City Council) has considered the potential environmental effects of transferring funds for the Ted Williams Parkway Overcrossing at Shoal Creek Drive; and

WHEREAS, on DEC 1 9 and City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the City Council, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because there is a negligible or no

expansion of use in the operation of the existing street and the project involves the construction of a small structure; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the transfer of funds from the Aldine Drive and Fairmount Drive Slope Restoration Project to the Ted Williams Parkway Overcrossing at Shoal Creek Drive Project is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15301 and 15303.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
