A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO APPLY FOR AND ACCEPT GRANT FUNDING FROM CALRECYCLE FOR THREE DIFFERENT TIRE RECYCLING GRANT PROGRAMS.

WHEREAS, the Environmental Services Department (ESD) is eligible to apply to the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) for grant funding from three tire recycling grant programs to promote the use of recycled, California-generated waste tires, pursuant to Sections 42872 and 42873 of the California Public Resources Code; and

WHEREAS, ESD proposes to partner with the City's Park & Recreation Department and Streets Division to use 100% recycled, California-generated waste tire products - rubberized pavement, tire derived aggregate (TDA), and tire-derived products (TDP) - for projects on City streets and recreational areas and in landfill gas or leachate projects; and

WHEREAS, the current maximum grant amounts are \$250,000 for the Rubberized Pavement grant, \$350,000 for the TDA grant, and \$150,000 for the TDP grant; NOW,

THEREFORE

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the Council President in his capacity under Charter section 265(i), or his designee, is authorized and directed to apply for, negotiate and execute agreements for, and accept grants funds from the California Department of Resources Recycling and Recovery (CalRecycle) with one to five-year terms for grants for the use of rubberized pavement, tire-derived aggregate, and tire-derived products for FY14 through and including FY16.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend grant

funds from CalRecyle for purposes of the above-described grants, contingent upon securing of

the grant funding and contingent upon receiving a fully executed grant agreement.

3. That the Environmental Services Director or Deputy Director is hereby

designated as the person authorized to conduct all grant negotiations and execute all CalRecyle

grant documents including, but not limited to, applications, agreements, amendments, and

payment requests which may be necessary to secure grant funding and to carry out and

administer the City's obligations, responsibilities, and duties under the terms and conditions of

the grant(s) obtained during FY14 through and including FY16.

4. That the City Comptroller is authorized to establish a separate fund to track

expenditures and receive grant-related reimbursements for eligible expenditures.
