A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ADOPTING THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO'S GOALS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015 –2019 FIVE YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN.

WHEREAS, the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) requires the City of San Diego (City) to prepare a Consolidated Plan (Plan) in order to receive federal housing and community development funding for all HUD entitlement grants; and

WHEREAS, the City's Fiscal Year 2015 – 2019 Plan (FY 2015 – 2019 Plan) must address four HUD entitlement programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG); HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME); Emergency Solutions Grants (ESG); and Housing Opportunities for Persons with AIDS (HOPWA); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the Plan includes: identifying the City's housing and community development needs, priorities and goals; identifying other federal, state, county, local and private sources of funding; and establishing a strategic plan for the City to follow in order to address such needs, priorities, and goals while considering the availability of other resources and mechanisms; and

WHEREAS, the Plan is updated every five years, and the FY 2015 – 2019 Plan must be submitted to HUD for review and approval on or before May 15, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City is developing its Plan in consultation with the intended primary beneficiaries of the HUD entitlement programs, the community, adjoining jurisdictions, and non-profit, for-profit and faith-based community organizations; and

WHEREAS, the process of developing the City's Plan includes assessing community needs, setting goals and developing strategies to address priority needs and objectives; and

WHEREAS, the goals and objectives established in the Plan will direct the funding for the FY 2015 – 2019 HUD grant program; and

WHEREAS, the City Council must approve the Plan goals prior to completion of the FY 2015 – 2019 Plan to avoid having funds misdirected to programs and plans that do not address the current needs within the City's low and moderate income communities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following goals for FY 2015 – FY 2019 Consolidated Plan are adopted:

- (1) Enhance the City's economic stability and prosperity by increasing opportunities for job readiness and investing in economic development programs;
- (2) Strengthen neighborhoods by investing in the City's critical public infrastructure needs;
- (3) Improve housing opportunities by creating and preserving affordable rental and homeowner housing in close proximity to transit, employment and community services;
- (4) Assist individuals and families to stabilize in permanent housing after experiencing a housing crisis or homelessness by providing client-appropriate housing and supportive service solutions;
- (5) Invest in community services and non-profit facilities that maximize impact by providing new or increased access to programs that serve highly vulnerable populations such as youth, seniors and food insecure households; and
