ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 20340 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE JAN 30 2014

AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO ADOPTING A LICENSE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AND SAN DIEGO CANYONLANDS
FOR CITY HEIGHTS CANYONS ENHANCEMENT AND
TRAILS PROJECT.

WHEREAS, in May 2012, the California Strategic Growth Council awarded San Diego Canyonlands (SDCL), a nonprofit organization, a grant in the amount of \$364,860 (Prop 84, Urban Greening Grant) for trail enhancements and signage, and restoration of 14 acres of habitat (Project) in Manzanita Canyon, Swan Canyon, 47th Street Canyon and Hollywood Canyon and Hollywood Park and Azalea Park (City Heights Canyons); and

WHEREAS, SDCL and City have negotiated the License Agreement to allow the Project on City fee-owned and easement property in the City Heights Canyons; and

WHEREAS, the Project will restore or enhance a total of 11.3 acres of upland habitat consisting of mixed chaparral and coastal sage scrub communities; and

WHEREAS, the Project will restore or enhance a total of 2.9 acres of wetlands habitat, including removal of debris, removal of non-native plant species, and planting of native species; and

WHEREAS, the Project will include trail activities, including closing some unofficial/user-defined trails, refurbishing four miles of existing trails, and installing trail structures such as stairs, puncheon bridges, switchbacks and retaining walls where necessary to provide continuous access; and

WHEREAS, the Project will provide signage, including trailhead signs, access points signs and trail markers, with the exception of trail segments that utilize sewer access roads, trails will not be greater than four feet in width and will be consistent with Multiple Habitat Planning Area (MHPA) standards; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Council President in his capacity under Charter section 265(i), or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of City, the License Agreement by and between the City and San Diego Canyonlands, on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO- 20340 (License Agreement).

Section 2. That the Mayor or his representative is authorized and directed to take all necessary actions to secure funding pursuant to the License Agreement, in an amount not to exceed \$20,000, to be placed in a special interest-bearing wasting fund for the purpose of maintenance of all new trail and signage facilities pursuant to the License Agreement.


Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to create a special interest-bearing wasting fund for the purpose of maintenance of all new trails and signage facilities pursuant to the License Agreement.

Section 4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to accept, appropriate and expend funds received from SDCL and interest earned on maintenance of all new trail and signage facilities pursuant to the License Agreement.

Section 5. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.


Section 6. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
