AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 18, OF THE SAN DIEGO MUNICIPAL CODE BY AMENDING SECTION 22.1801, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, ARTICLE 2, DIVISION 24 BY AMENDING SECTION 22.2401 RELATING TO THE DEVELOPMENT SERVICES DEPARTMENT AND ADDING SECTION 22.2402 RELATING TO THE DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING, NEIGHBORHOODS, AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT.

WHEREAS, on October 28, 2013, the City Council approved the Chief Operating Officer's proposed improvements to the City's governmental operations described in Report to the City Council, No. 13-076, dated October 21, 2013 (Reorganization Report); and

WHEREAS, the approved Reorganization Report calls for moving the City's planning function out of the Development Services Department and into a separate Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development, which requires City Council approval pursuant to San Diego Charter section 26; and

WHEREAS, the amendments to the Municipal Code clarify the duties of the Development Services Director and Planning Director as a result of the reorganization of the Development Services Department and the creation of a new Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development; and

WHEREAS, the Planning Director's duties include the responsibility and authority over long range planning, California Environmental Quality Act policy and environmental resource analysis, economic development, and various other planning functions such as the civic innovation lab, sustainability planning, and urban design studio; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That Chapter 2, Article 2, Division 18 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by amending section 22.1801, to read as follows:

§22.1801 City Departments

Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development

Police through Water Utilities [No change in text.]

Section 2. That Chapter 2, Article 2, Division 24 of the San Diego Municipal Code is amended by amending section 22.2401 and adding 22.2402, to read as follows:

Division 24: Development Services Department and Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development

§22.2401 Development Services Department — Powers and Duties of the Development Services Director

- (a) The Development Services Department is a City department. The department provides review, permit issuance, inspection, and code enforcement services for private and public development. The Director is the administrative head of the department and shall be appointed by and may be removed by the City Manager.
- (b) [No change in text.]

(c) The Development Services Director, under the direction of the City

Manager, shall be responsible for enforcing the provisions of the Land

Development Code (San Diego Municipal Code chapters 10-15).

§22.2402 Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development— Powers and Duties of the Planning Director

- (a) The Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development is a City department. The department is responsible for long-range planning of the City's communities and neighborhoods. The department's responsibilities also include economic development programs, historic resource analysis, the multiple species conservation program, and environmental policy and analysis. An environmental section responsible for all California Environmental Quality Act policy in the City shall serve as a section of the department. The Planning Director is the administrative head of the department and shall be appointed by and may be removed by the City Manager.
- (b) The Planning Director, under the direction of the City Manager and with policy direction of the City Council and policy guidance and recommendations of the Planning Commission, shall be responsible for performing those duties and functions as assigned and directed by the City Manager. Such activities, as may be assigned, shall be performed as required by federal, state and local law and regulations as may be promulgated by the City Manager.
- (c) The environmental section of the Department of Planning, Neighborhoods, and Economic Development, shall maintain that degree of independence

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in the performance of its functions and duties as will assure the City

Manager, the City Council, Planning Commission and the people of the

City of San Diego that its review and analysis of the environmental

consequences of projects under its purview, whether beneficial or

detrimental, are independent and wholly objective and are not prepared for

the purpose of either supporting or detracting from any project, plan or

position, whether advanced by the City, any other governmental agency, a

developer, a citizen or a group of citizens.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a

written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its

passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from

and after its final passage.
