AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING TO EXECUTE THE THIRD AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH ROESLING NAKAMURA TERADA ARCHITECTS, INC. FOR THE LA JOLLA COVE LIFEGUARD STATION.

WHEREAS, on October 14, 2002, Roesling Nakamura Terada Architects, Inc. (RNT) was selected in accordance with Council Policy 300-7, and entered into an agreement with the City of San Diego in the amount of \$83,856; and

WHEREAS, on May 04, 2010, Council approved the first amendment to the agreement to update the plans in order to meet the current building code and re-design portions of the facility; and

WHEREAS, on October 2, 2012, Council approved the second amendment to the agreement to provide construction support and to prepare the as-builts drawings; and

WHEREAS, the proposed third amendment to the agreement with RNT is required to modify the design of the observation tower as requested by the lifeguard staff; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, a third amendment to the agreement with Roesling Nakamura Terada Architects for the Professional Architectural Services in CIP S-00792, La Jolla Cove Lifeguard Station, in an amount not to exceed \$45,375.00, for the purpose of completing the La Jolla Cove Lifeguard Station, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No. **20391**.

Section 2. The Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$45,375 from CIP S-00792, La Jolla Cove Lifeguard Station Project, Fund 400848, Def. Maint 2012A-Proj., for the purpose of executing this amendment to the agreement.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
