

ORDINANCE NUMBER O- 20413 (NEW SERIES)

DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE OCT 14 2014

AN ORDINANCE EXEMPTING ONE DEPUTY DIRECTOR POSITION AND TWO PROGRAM MANAGER POSITIONS IN THE DEPARTMENT OF INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY FROM THE CLASSIFIED SERVICE.

WHEREAS, on July 29, 2014, the City of San Diego (City)'s Civil Service Commission reviewed a request from the Department of Information Technology (Department) to exempt one Deputy Director position and two Program Manager positions from the Classified Service; and

WHEREAS, the Deputy Director will be responsible for managing the Information Technology (IT) Contract Management section of the Department, which includes managing the City's IT service contract portfolio for network, data center, and technology services, and will establish Department policies and processes related to contract governance, compliance, change orders, renewals, and dispute resolution; and

WHEREAS, the two Program Managers will be part of the Contract Management section, and will manage the IT contract lifecycle for the City network, data center, and technology services. These Program Managers will also recommend policy and procedural changes, and will assume the IT contract oversight functions from other personnel in the Department, allowing that staff to focus on IT operations and service to City departments; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Charter (Charter) section 117(a)(17) states that the Unclassified Service shall include "[m]anagerial employees having significant responsibilities for formulating or administering departmental policies and programs. Each such position shall be exempted from the Classified Service by ordinance, upon the initiation of the appropriate appointing authority and after receiving the advisory review and comment of the Civil Service Commission and the approval of the City Council"; and

WHEREAS, on August 4, 2014, upon review of the duties and responsibilities of the Deputy Director position and the Program Manager positions, as provided by the Department, the Civil Service Commission determined that the Deputy Director position and the Program Manager positions meet the standard set forth in Charter section 117(a)(17) to be placed in the Unclassified Service; and

WHEREAS, the finding of the Civil Service Commission is set forth in a memorandum dated August 7, 2014, from Hadi Dehghani, Personnel Director, to the Honorable Council President and City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Council has received and reviewed a Memorandum from Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani, dated August 7, 2014, which documents that, on August 4, 2014, the City's Civil Service Commission reviewed and favorably commented on a proposal from the Department to exempt from the City's Classified Service one Deputy Director position and two Program Manager positions in the Department. The Deputy Director will oversee the IT Contract Management section of the Department, and the Program Managers will be part of the IT Contract Management section.

Section 2. That pursuant to Charter section 117(a)(17), with the Civil Service Commission's review and approval, the Council now exempts from the Classified Service and declares to be in the Unclassified Service of the City one Deputy Director position and two Program Manager positions in the Department of Information Technology, performing the duties set forth in the August 7, 2014, Memorandum from Personnel Director Hadi Dehghani to the Honorable Council President and City Council.

Section 3. That a full reading of this Ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
