AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A NINTH AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH OPPER & VARCO, LLP, FOR LEGAL SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE CLEAN-UP OF CONTAMINATION TO THE QUALCOMM STADIUM PROPERTY AND THE MISSION VALLEY AQUIFER.

WHEREAS, the City retained the legal services of Opper & Varco, LLP, as special environmental counsel in connection with Clean-up & Abatement Order No. 92-01, issued by the San Diego Regional Water Quality Control Board (Water Board), that required the clean-up of soil and groundwater underlying the Qualcomm Stadium property contaminated by the release of petroleum products at the Mission Valley Terminal; and

WHEREAS, the City is the owner of the Qualcomm Stadium property and has Pueblo water rights in the underlying groundwater basin; and

WHEREAS, the City filed litigation against the discharger in 2007, which is on appeal; and

WHEREAS, the City also filed litigation appealing a decision of the Water Board related to the clean-up; and

WHEREAS, the enforcement action by the Water Board and the litigation matters against the discharger and the Water Board are ongoing and require the continued services of special environmental counsel, as well as additional funding, for one year beyond the expiration of the current agreement; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and directed to execute, for and on behalf of the City, the Ninth Amendment to the Agreement with Opper & Varco, LLP, for an additional one-year term, through December 31, 2016, and an additional \$100,000, for a total contract amount not to exceed \$578,000 for environmental legal services in connection with the clean-up of contamination to the Qualcomm Stadium property and the Mission Valley Aquifer from releases of petroleum products at the Mission Valley Terminal, under the terms and conditions set forth in the Ninth Amendment to Agreement between the City of San Diego and Opper & Varco, LLP, for Legal Services.

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$100,000 from Fund No. 700011 – Water Utility Operating Fund, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the above Ninth Amendment, provided that the Chief Financial Officer first furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds necessary for this expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasury.

Section 3. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 4. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
