A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE COUNCIL PRESIDENT TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND TAKE ALL NECESSARY ACTIONS TO SECURE UP TO \$30,000 IN FISCAL YEAR 2011 PORT SECURITY GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING AND AUTHORIZING THE CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER TO APPROPRIATE AND EXPEND THESE MONIES CONTINGENT UPON SECURING THE GRANT FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the San Diego Port Region has identified \$600,000 of available funds to apply towards additional regional port security projects through the FY 2011 Port Security Grant Program (PSGP 11); and

WHEREAS, the Port of San Diego, as the regional fiduciary agent, is making this funding available to any non-Federal Area Maritime Security Committee and regional maritime partner for potential port and maritime security projects; and

WHEREAS, these projects must meet PSGP 11 grant guidance guidelines and must be completed by August 31, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the City has been awarded \$30,000 from PSGP 11 to use for training and exercising of Preventative Radiological/Nuclear Detection (PRND) equipment and continuity of operations; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the training and exercise is to demonstrate proficiency associated with the Personal Radiation Detector and the Radioactive Isotope Identification Device; and

WHEREAS, conducted in a realistic maritime environment, the drill involves local law enforcement agents using radiation detectors to detect, locate, identify, and adjudicate disposition for scenarios related to potential threat radiological materials; and

WHEREAS, the PRND equipment offers portable and reliable detection tools that can be safely and discretely operated by officers in the field; and

WHEREAS, the equipment is easily operated, but it requires periodic retraining in order to provide the best response and most efficient use of the equipment; and

WHEREAS, the project offers efficient use of funds to continue an annual training effort and to provide nine local, state, and federal agencies enhanced situational awareness in the field of radiological and nuclear detection; and

WHEREAS, by providing a funding source for the training, City agencies will have the ability to practice, demonstrate, and validate PRND training that they developed over the previous two years; and

WHEREAS, the equipment used in this training was procured previously; and WHEREAS, the fiscal impact to the General Fund is \$30,000; and

WHEREAS, this grant is reimbursable in nature and requires the City to expend funds prior to requesting reimbursement; and

WHEREAS, expenditures will be initially sourced from the City's General Fund Fire-Rescue Department budget, and then reimbursed by the San Diego Unified Port District via the Department of Homeland Security; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Council President in his capacity under Charter section 265(i), or his designee, is authorized and directed to apply for, accept, and to take all necessary actions to secure funding of up to \$30,000 in Fiscal Year 2011 Port Security Grant Program Funding from the San Diego Unified Port District via the Department of Homeland Security for the purpose of funding an exercise in Preventative Radiological/Nuclear Detection in the San Diego Region.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized and directed to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$30,000 from Fund 600001 Grant 1000421-2011 contingent upon the grant funding being secured and contingent upon receiving a fully executed grant agreement.
