DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE FEB 12 2014

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO DETERMINING THAT THE INSTALLATION OF ANGLE PARKING ON LANDIS STREET IS CATEGORICALLY EXEMPT FROM THE CALIFORNIA ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY ACT PURSUANT TO EXEMPTIONS 15301.

WHEREAS, the Transportation Engineering Operations Division of the Transportation and Stormwater Department has received a request to convert parallel parking to angled parking on the south side of Landis Street between 36th Street and Cherokee Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the California Environmental Quality Act (CEQA), Public Resources Code section 21084, states that the CEQA Guidelines shall list those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment and which shall be exempt from CEQA; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to that authority, CEQA Guidelines sections 15300-15333 list the categorical exemptions promulgated by the California Office of Planning and Research for those classes of projects which have been determined not to have a significant effect on the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego has considered the potential environmental effects of the angled parking on Landis Street; and


WHEREAS, on JAN 28 2014, the City Council held a duly noticed public meeting and considered the written record for the project as well as public comment; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of San Diego, using its independent judgment, has determined that the project will not have a significant effect on the environment because it involves a minor alteration to an existing street with negligible or no expansion of use; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the angled parking on the south side of Landis Street between 36th Street and Cherokee Avenue is categorically exempt from CEQA pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Council of the City of San Diego has determined that an exception to the exemption as set forth in CEQA Guidelines section 15300.2 does not apply.
